First Quarter--

Second Quarter--

Fuerza came out strong after the whistle, and scored the first goal of the quarter by Rodolfo Monroy at 13:10. 6:46 Power Play Goal by James Katajwa, (Fuerza Latina PEN for 6th Penalty). Kings lead 8-1. James netted 2 additional goals in the 2nd quarter, to give him a hat track in just 15 minutes.

The score at half time was 11-1 --Kings.

Third Quarter--

Just three goals in the 3rd quarter. Mirsad opens the scoring in the third quarter for the KC Kings in the 13th minute. The scoring slowed down a bit with additional scores from Nick Kelly (7:30) and Mirsad (4:50). Kings leading 14-1 at the end of three.

Fourth Quarter--

Nick Kelly scored the first goal of the 4th quarter, which saw, Chaz, Lucas and Stefan all add additional goals in the final quarter. Final score 18-1 Kings.
